

RFE consists of presentations that educate young people about; safe partying behaviours, the impact of a decision made in a moment, the transitions of high school and lastly their inherent worth and value.




RFE equips young people with the information, advice and tools necessary to assist them in navigating many of the challenges they may face in this unique season of life.

LIFE AFTER YEAR 12

We have rebuilt our "Party Safe Seminar" into a new talk:

Students on the brink of graduating from high school are excited to step into the world as fully fledged adults. We want to equip them with helpful hints and tips on how to 'adult' well and navigate this transition, being mindful of the impact that changes can bring. We speak into healthy habits, safety and managing their resources such as time, emotions and money.

At this stage of life society seemingly hands them a check list recipe for perceived happiness and success; a qualification, job, life partner, house and 2.5 children. We encourage them that their journey is their own and it can be as successful as they choose to make it. We believe a powerful skill to learn, is introspection, as it is needed in order to shift our own perspective on the events of life and focus on what is good or what can be good.

We believe in the potential of the next generation and we want to contribute to a firm foundation from which they can launch.

INSIDE OUT - GRADE 10s

The amount of pressure from peers, parents, teachers and societal voices significantly increases by Grade 10. As their pace of life changes, we want to slow things down and remind them of the importance of knowing their "why" behind the decisions that they make.

We speak into behavioural patterns that encourage self care and strength of character. We also highlight potentially harmful decisions and destructive avenues of behaviour.

We use stories and engaging analogies which students can relate to, to explain lessons and principles that guide our goals above

SELFIE - GRADE 8s

This talk addresses Grade 8s and the big leap into high school. As the title suggests, we want to speak into their 'self' as the core of who they are and what shapes to their identity. They are taking a tremendous amount of selfies but how much do they actually know about themselves? We share different ways to know yourself and care for and invest in your emotional and mental wellbeing. This talk focuses on providing practical tools to achieve helpful boundaries and healthy relationships.

We tell stories that illustrate the journey and benefits of knowing your value and worth and the concept of every action having a reaction. We use these methods and lessons to also talk into current cultural challenges such as social media, online influences and digital consumption.
